DELIVERY:

2 days 'up-front' classroom style delivery + 3 on-farm follow-up sessions over 10-12 months

- Day 1 focuses on grazing management – understanding the science behind good grazing recommendations and introducing a 'Rotation Right' system as a simple way to implement and manage good grazing
- Day 2 focuses on profitable feeding – the role of supplements and the interaction between grazing, supplement use and cow performance

Each follow up session has a specific focus, such as managing the transition from summer pastures to autumn pastures, the spring flush and the seed-head phase, and the transition into the summer.
